


Meet a student






























Macmillan Coffee Morning




On the 21st of October 2022 TWA hosted their first ever Macmillian Coffee Morning. Macmillan provide amazing support to those with cancer.

Staff and students made cakes and decorated the school and it was great to welcome parents and carers to join us too!





















Become a Parent Governor
