Bowling!


At the end of Summer Term 1, it was decided to plan a reward visit to bowling in Coventry.


As a whole school, we worked towards supporting each other in making the right choices to earn full points or staying on green on our BEAR system.

We had children from every year group attend the visit and all children took part in two / three games of bowling. Amongst all the children and some staff, there was lots of healthy competition taking place.


The children did very well and were excellent representatives of TWA showing respect to the public.

Not to mention how incredibly well they played with some scoring over 100 points.












Young Leaders



Students have been attending young Leaders sessions throughout the Summer term and have all made tremendous progress.


Led by Sarah, the sessions mix games, problem solving and self awareness skills that each student builds on each week.


The end of each sessions ends in team games that the students thoroughly enjoy and look forward to each week.
